I want to encourage you to participate in a new activity for the coming year. You have probably heard of a "Book of the Month Club." Beginning in January, we are having a "Book of the Month Club" here at First Christian Church. Each month, a certain book or books of the Bible will be designated as the book everyone is encouraged to read. A study guide will be made available with questions about the content of that book. In addition, I will be preaching from that book during that particular month.

There could be several benefits from this plan. One, it will help the participants to have a greater knowledge of that section of Scripture. Second, many who undertake to read all of the Bible in a certain time frame such as a year will often become discouraged and quit before finishing. By breaking the Bible into smaller sections, the assignment of reading the Bible becomes more manageable. By the time the year ends, the participants will have read several books of the Bible.

The first book we will be reading is Genesis. Be sure to pick up your study guide as soon as you can. On Wednesday nights, the adults will begin a new study entitled "You'll Get Through This." This study is based upon a book by that same title written by Max Lucado. The study looks at the life of Joseph, son of Jacob, taken out of the last thirteen chapters of Genesis. This study will reinforce what we are reading from the book of Genesis as our book of the month. This study will begin on January 10. I hope that you can be a part of it.




Genesis

Greater knowledge of the Bible Help one develop consistency in Bible reading.






Women's Ministry Meeting


