

"What the world needs now, is love, sweet love. It's the only thing that there's just too little of." The lack of love for one another will eventually and certainly destroy us. That sad and awful truth is illustrated very clearly in the following poem.

The Cold Within

Six humans trapped by happenstance in bleak and bitter cold. Each one possessed a stick of wood or so the story's told. Their dying fire in need of logs, the first man held his back

For of the faces 'round the fire he noticed one was black. The next man looking cross the way saw one not of his church

And couldn't bring himself to give the fire his stick of birch. The third one sat in tattered clothes; he gave his coat a hitch

Why should his log be put to use to warm the idle rich? The rich man just sat back and thought of the wealth he had in store And how to keep what he had earned from the lazy shiftless poor. The black man's face bespoke revenge as the fire passed from his sight:

For all he saw in his stick of wood was a chance to spite the white. The last man of this forlorn group did naught except for gain; Giving only to those who gave was how he played the game.

Their logs held tight in death's still hand were proof of human sin. They didn't die from the cold without; they died from the cold within.

The words of that 1965 song are still true. "What the world needs now is love sweet love. Not just for some but for everyone." The golden text of the Bible, John 3:16, says that God loved the world.
