Ponderings of the Preacher...

I hope that you had an enjoyable Fourth of July celebration. Every nation in the world has a fourth of July but only the United States of America has the kind of Fourth that we do. As you know, we celebrate our country's independence on that day because it was on July 4, 1776 that the second Continental Congress adopted the Declaration of Independence declaring that the 13 colonies were breaking ties with Great Britain.

There are many patriotic songs that are sung to honor our country but none (in my mind) any more pointed as to the source of our freedom than "God Bless America." We sang the song as a congregation this past Sunday morning in our worship service and this past Sunday evening at our picnic. I don't know what others are thinking when they join in singing this song, but I am offering the song as a prayer to God. "God, please bless America. May you stand beside her and guide her through the night with a light from above."

The song became quite popular through the dark days leading up to and then going through the Second World War. Kate Smith was the artist who is most well known as the singer of this song. Something that I did not know was that there are introductory lyrics to the song that we never sing. Those lyrics are:

> "While the storm clouds gather far across the sea Let us swear allegiance to a land that's free Let us all be grateful for a land so fair, As we raise our voices in a solemn prayer."

I don't suppose it should surprise me that we never use those lyrics anymore. We certainly would not want to acknowledge God in a public forum and offer a prayer to Him. Instead of a plea for God's blessings, I have to wonder if many may be singing the words as a demand for God to bless our land. We are undeserving of His blessings and we desperately need His grace and mercy. So join me in prayer asking God to please bless America again.




