Ponderings of the Preacher ...

As I read the New Testament, I find that God's people when faced with major decisions would pray seeking God's will on the matter and would often fast. Our Lord Himself as He was preparing to begin His public ministry went into the wilderness and there fasted and I would assume prayed. Before appointing 12 of His disciples to be apostles, Jesus spend all night in prayer. Barnabas and Saul (Paul) along with two others were worshiping and fasting as they were seeking the Lord's guidance. I would urge the members of our church to earnestly seek the Lord's guidance during these next few days to be able to make the right decision. The question that should be asked is not whether I want Martin to be the next Senior Pastor but whether God wants Martin to be the next Senior Pastor.

He would be glad to talk with you and discuss the future of First Christian Church and what you and he can do to accomplish God's will in this community. Talk to one or all of the elders. I will be preaching this next Sunday and Martin will be preaching on January 30. I hope to see each of you this coming Sunday as we gather together for worship.






Books, Books, Books
