Ponderings of the Preacher . . .

Yesterday, I shared a message concerning the image of God. Man was created in the image of God (Genesis 1:26-28), Jesus Christ is the image of God (Colossians 1:15), the person who is a new creation in Christ is being remade in God's image (Colossians 3:9-10), and when Jesus comes again His followers will become like Him (1 John 3:2-3). What a unique position man holds in God's creation! With blessings come responsibilities. What is the responsibility that accompanies this blessed position of being made in the very image of God? I shared the following in the sermon, but I think it deserves repeating.

Jesus was often questioned by His enemies to trap Him in His words. They hoped to be able to find reason to accuse Him to the Roman authorities or to cause Him to lose esteem with the people. On one of those occasions, Jesus was asked whether it was lawful to pay taxes to Caesar. This was a no-win question. If He answered that it was lawful, then He would lose popularity with the people and if He answered that it was not lawful, He would be in trouble with the Roman government. How would He respond?

Jesus told His questioners to show Him a coin used for paying the tax. He then asked whose image was on the coin. The reply was "Caesar." Jesus then stated, "Give to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's." This silenced His accusers, but it is too bad that someone did not follow up this answer by asking another question. "What bears God's image and what should we give to Him?"

According to Genesis 1, humans bear the image of God. Therefore, we should give our very lives to God. "you were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness." (Ephesians 4:22-24) "Therefore, I urge you brothers, in view of God's mercy to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not be conformed any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." (Romans 12:1-2)

May we reflect the image of God in our lives every day that we live! May we be like the one whose image we bear by being righteous and holy!

I hope to see each of you this coming Lord's Day morning. Let's all do our best to be present when the church meets for worship and fellowship!




Genesis




