Ponderings of the Preacher . . .

Who would have imagined that on Easter Sunday night an accumulating snow would have fallen? Making this even more amazing is the fact that this occurred on April Fools' Day. Some people have called this a trick played by Mother Nature. At any rate there are a couple of things for which we can be thankful: the snow was beautiful and it won't hang around very long.

Did you also find it interesting that Easter fell on April 1 this year? That hadn't happened since 1956. Let me share with you a few observations about the connection between the events of Easter and April Fools' Day.

April Fools' Day is a day we often observe as a day for tricks and jokes. Although this was not a day being observed during the time of Jesus, can you imagine how the resurrection of Jesus might have fit in with this concept? The devil using wicked men carried off the greatest crime in the history of mankind. Jesus Christ the Son of God, Creator of the Universe, was executed. The devil probably thought that he had ruined God's plan by killing Jesus. I think that this illustrates that the devil is not allknowing as our God is. I don't believe that he understood how all of this fit in with the plan of God. Little did he know that Jesus' death would make possible the forgiveness of sins for all men and that Jesus would be raised from the dead three days later. For a short period of time, the devil probably thought that he had beaten God, but when Jesus was victoriously raised to life on the first day of the week it was time for God to say, "April Fools!" God's magnificent plan of salvation that had been in the works since before the creation of the world had now been accomplished! Hallelujah!

Unfortunately, there are many who have not accepted the salvation Jesus made possible at the cross nor have they received Jesus as Lord of their lives. Many have even denied the existence of God and the identity of Jesus as the Son of God. The Bible speaks of those who are in that state. "The fool says in his heart, 'There is no God.'" (Psalms 14:1). God has assigned us the task of sharing the message of salvation with those people. May we remain faithful in carrying out that task!


