## **Politics!**

Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

## - Jeremiah 29:7 (NIV)

Jeremiah 29 records a letter the Prophet Jeremiah sent to all the people "Nebuchadnezzar had carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon." (Jer. 29:1). The letter gives instructions from God to the Israelites who were taken from their land and now living in a country that did not share their values, customs, or beliefs.

In the letter, God tells them to settle down, even though their most likely instinct was to leave. He tells them to plant a garden, to form families, and to "increase in numbers", which would have reminded them of the Garden of Eden and God's purpose for humankind. He also tells them to "seek the peace and prosperity" of the place they end up in. Lastly, God tells them to pray "for it", in favor of that land and government, "because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

Yesterday, our president gave the State of the Union Address. Whether you support him or you don't we all should be praying for him and his administration, as well as for congress. We find this encouragement to pray not only in the Old Testament, but also in the New Testament:

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people - for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.

## 1st Timothy 2:1-2 (NIV)

As our country is preparing for the start of a new election cycle, I ask you to seek the peace and prosperity of our nation by having civil, rational, and calm conversations about the issues (if you choose to do so), specially in social media. Remember that you are "ambassadors for Christ" (2<sup>nd</sup> Cor. 5:20), so your actions and words are representing Jesus to those who don't know Him. I urge you to focus more on gaining your brother or sister for Christ than the argument; to care more about your brother or sister than an issue.

Don't get me wrong, the issues are important and your vote and participation on the local and national discourse is important. However, I ask you to remember two things:

First, we should be quick to listen and slow to speak. Listen to their concerns or needs and give a Gospel-center solution to those concerns or needs. Second, remember that whatever the issue is, it is temporary in comparison to our eternal life, so don't forget your mission to glorify God in everything you do, and to introduce people to Him.




