### Take a Moment

Life can be very busy and stressful. Some of you are running around with the kids and grandkids, others are busy with work or homework, and others are dealing with illness that take a lot of your time and energy.

During these times, it is perfectly normal, and human, to seek rest and peace. To want to stay home in your pajamas and watch Netflix for a couple of hours, or to take those extra 15-30 minutes of sleep in the weekend, especially on Sundays.

The Bible encourages us of two things: "not giving up meeting together" (Heb. 10:25a) and to "seek to show hospitality." (Rom. 12:13b).

It is true that Covid made it easy for us to get used to reducing the regular meetings we used to have and to stop showing "hospitality". We want to encourage you to make an effort to "not *give* up meeting together" by coming to church regularly and to one of our groups.

I also would like to encourage you to "seek to show hospitality" by inviting some of our church members to eat at your house, or going to a restaurant together. This was a common practice in the first century church, and I think that we have neglected it.


To encourage conversations in our church, we are changing the way we start the church service after Easter. We will have a prelude, a welcome, a time to say hello, a song, and then announcements and prayer as usual.

If you are struggling with hospitality, let us help you take three easy steps:

- Get to church at 9:40am, go to the fellowship room, and visit with whomever is there (you may also get some snacks and coffee if you want to).
- During our church service, take the time to have a brief conversation with 3 people or say hello and learn the name of at least 5 people you don't know in our congregation.
- Stay 15 minutes after church and have a conversation with some of the members of your church family.

And if you want to go the extra mile, plan hosting a meal at your home 2-3 times this summer. Jesus extended hospitality, the disciples encouraged it, the early church practiced it, and now is time for us to make it part of our church life.


