

THE CHRISTIAN CHURCH FAMILY

To help members of our church family better know each other we will intermittently use this space to tell you more about a member. We will start with someone everyone knows by sight but may not know how she came to be here.

CLEONE BLOEMKER

She has been our church secretary since June, 2012. But she came to First Christian Church in 1973 at the invitation of her sister-in-law, Cheryl Bloemker. Cleone was born in St. Louis, MO., October 15, 1950 to John & Virginia Weiffenbach. Her father was a native of Dieterich and her mother and grandparents. John and Emma Bottom, owned the drugstore in Dieterich. Due to her mother's illness, Cleone and her siblings entered the Illinois Masonic Children's Home in LaGrange, IL when Cleone was 10. Her siblings are John (Cathy) Weiffenbach and her sister is Audrey (Burl) Griffith of Dieterich. She lived at the Home until she graduated high school. Cleone wants people to know the Home is not what generally comes to mind when thinking of a "children's home". The children were not available for adoption. They were taken on a vacation every summer. Also, the children were taken shopping for new clothing every season and if desired they would have been sent to college.

They visited relatives in Dieterich often and that is where she met Rocky Bloemker. She and Rocky were married in August, 1970. Their son, Troy, was born in 1971 and daughter, Tracey (Scoggins) in 1982. Cleone has 4 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. Rocky was an Effingham City Policeman and died of a brain tumor October 29, 2007.

Cleone has a two year degree from Lake Land College in Mattoon and an online degree in Information Technology from Franklin University in Ohio. She worked 31 years at World Color Printing Press Co.

Cleone says she has been so blessed by the Lord. She had Christian parents and Christian based children's home to grow up in to adulthood. Being a part of the First Christian Church family has brought her relationship with the Lord closer each year. When she first came here, she was extremely shy. As the years progressed, she has been able to teach, lead a ladies' group, go on mission trips and be the church secretary. She had no experience in any of these service opportunities before being asked to serve. She says she is still learning and studying the Bible. "I still fall short of the mark, but the Lord renews me every morning. She has been teaching our children for 45 years! First Christian Church is blessed to have Cleone as a member and as our church secretary. She goes above and beyond in both.
