Hello church family,

Summer is going well. I had a great time at Oil Belt camp, and we are in the middle of soccer camp. Most of you are taking trips and enjoying some time off.

I wanted to take this time to update you on a couple of things:

- · We reworked the budget lines to make it work better for our needs, and we are publishing the 2023-2024 proposed budget this Sunday June 25th. It's a little late (sorry about that), but I think that the reworks and the information we provide to you will better help you understand our finances. We ask you to take a copy and read it. If you have any questions, please let any of the elders know, so that we can either answer it or find the answer to your question. We will be voting on your approval after our church service on July 9th.
- We also reworked the leadership nomination papers (elders and deacons) to better help you study and pray over the qualified men you are nominating. We ask you to take the time to read the scriptures and to pray about the matter; then return your form with your nominations (if any) by July 9th, so that we can start the process of "testing" those nominations.
- Lastly, we have met with the real estate agent and made a list of repairs and updates needed in the parsonage to put it on the market as soon as possible. Based on the last congregational meeting's vote, the elders have approved a \$10,000 budget for that. I have asked John Donathan to oversee the cleaning and repairs with the help of Chris Hutchinson. The main repair that is keeping us from putting the house on the market is the repair of the air conditioner unit. If you have any questions, please let me or John Donathan know.

I want to thank you for being patient with all of these issues and encourage you to continue to pray for us and to get involved in the different ministries we have. God has given you gifts and skills to further His Kingdom, and it is our prayer that you be encouraged to use them.


